This commission is for a 15-minute original score to accompany cutting-edge projection mapping, motion graphics, and filmed dance.

The project is led by Nottingham based award-winning dance company, Tom Dale Company, and Vent Media, in partnership with Nottingham City Council.

Project Concept

This project will bridge the timeless elegance of classical mathematics and architecture with cutting-edge innovations such as AI, biomimicry, and visions of an optimistic future. Nature, an eternal muse for human creativity, will serve as the central theme, interwoven through sound, movement, and visual art.

Music Requirements

The commissioned score will be:

- Electronic, multi-layered, and immersive, designed to complement the dynamic interplay of projection, movement, and motion graphics.

- Textured with evolving rhythms, tonalities, and spatial arrangements that synchronize with the dance and visual elements.

- Able to evoke both the timeless beauty of nature and the forward-looking themes of the project.
